#### **(4) Minister for Forestry tours Bago, Magway Divisions**

YANGON, 10 May Minister for Forestry Lt-Gen Chit Swe inspected establishment and conservation of forests, forest reserves and greening of the arid regions in Bago and Magway Divisions from 6 May till yesterday.

He arrived at Nathmaw Rafting Station of Myanmar Timber Enterprise in Pyaw and inspected tasks on 6 May.

He later inspected forest nursery at Thabyaygaing in Kanma Township where he heard reports on establishment of forest plantations for commercial use and greening and conservation of forests.

At Wundwin Rafting Station in Mindon-Kanma timber extraction area, the minister gave instructions on timber extraction, prevention of loss and wastage and measures for reducing illegal timber extraction.

The Forest Department is initiating community forestry system by which the department systematically hands over community forest plantations and forests to enable regional people to manage the forests and extract timber on their own in accord with the rules.

At Shwesettaw Wildlife Sanctuary on 7 May, the minister inspected the training hall designated for opening a course to be jointly conducted by the Wildlife Research Centre of Japan and the Forest Resource, Environment and Development Association (FREDA).

Lt-Gen Chit Swe left instructions on conservation of golden deer and other rare species and tasks for ever-greening of the sanctuary, nature tourism and personnel welfare.

He met township authorities, departmental personnel and regional people in Sedoktara.

At Mon Creek Dam Project site on 8 May, he heard reports on progress of work and conditions of watershed forests in the area of the dam and gave instructions on long-term durability of the dam, gap planting system for watershed forests and conservation of the watershed forests. He later inspected Wethekan Bird Sanctuary in Salin Township.

He met township authorities and departmental officials at Salin Township Law and Order Restoration Council.

He next inspected timber extraction in Seikphyu Township and work for afforestation along Seikphyu-Pakokku Road.

Yesterday, Lt-Gen Chit Swe inspected Hsinchaung watershed nursery in Yezagyo Township, tasks for greening of Shinmadaung region, the Agro-Forestry Training Centre jointly established by OISCA group of Japan and Forest Department in Yezagyo Township, forest conservation in Pakokku Township and Lawkananda Wildlife Sanctuary in Bagan-NeaungU.
