YANGON, 13 June-The ASEAN Leading Committee held its first meeting at the Office of the Commander-in-Chief (Army) this afternoon with an address by Chairman of the Leading Committee Secretary-1 of the State Law and Order Restoration Council Lt-Gen Khin Nyunt.

YANGON, 13 June-President Mr Handojo Santosa of PT Japfa Comfeed Indonesia Tbk and party called on Member of the State Law and Order Restoration Council Chairman of Myanmar Investment Commission Deputy Prime Minister Vice-Admiral Maung Maung Khin at his office this afternoon.

They discussed economic cooperation on mutual basis and investment opportunities for extension of communications services, breeding, feedstuff production and power generation.

(4) Early initiation of new sugar mill project in Lewe Township stressed

YANGON, 13 June - Minister for Agriculture and Irrigation Lt-Gen Myint Aung inspected Pathi Dam and a sugar mill in Bago Division yesterday.

Accompanied by Chairman of Bago Division Law and Order Restoration Council Commander of Southern Command Maj-Gen Kyi Aung and officials, he observed inflow of water at Pathi Dam in Toungoo Township.

Officials should strive to ensure better inflow of water at the dam, to beautify the environs and to set up coffee and rubber plantations for the private sector in nearby areas of the project, he stressed.
